

**Resolution to Modify the Lakewood City Schools Master School Facilities Plan:  
To Remove One Elementary School from the Plan:  
To Move from Seven to Six Elementary Schools**

seconded the motion that the following resolution be adopted:

WHEREAS, in 2004 the Lakewood City Schools and the Ohio School Facilities Commission agreed on a Long-Range Master School Facilities Program for Lakewood City Schools' participation in the OSFC Expedited Local Partnership Program; and,

WHEREAS, this Master School Facilities Plan provided Lakewood City Schools with one high school, two middle schools, and seven elementary schools; and,

WHEREAS, the Ohio School Facilities Commission has indicated that due to changing student enrollments, state funding assistance will not be available for more than six elementary schools;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lakewood City Board of Education has determined:

1. That our Master School Facilities Plan be modified to provide for one high school, two middle schools and six elementary schools;
2. That our Master School Facilities Plan be modified to include \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ Elementary Schools as the fifth and sixth elementary schools in this Plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT WHILE THE Lakewood City Board of Education understands, supports and desires to comply with the desire to not close any elementary school prior to completion of the construction of the two Phase III elementary schools, current fiscal challenges to the school district may leave the school district without the ability to comply with this wish.

Upon roll call on the adoption of the resolution, the vote was as follows:
