On November 30, 2015, at approximately 1559 hours, I was at Lakewood
 Hospital and was flagged down by the ER staff about a juvenile report
 that needed to be filed. PA Barnhardt advised me that SUB/ [REDACTED]
 [REDACTED] was transported to Lakewood ER by her mother, COM/ [REDACTED]
 [REDACTED]. [REDACTED]'S father, OIV/ [REDACTED], had arrived at Lakewood

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Hospital after [REDACTED] was put into ER room #5.

[REDACTED] was in the ED for an overdose. [REDACTED] had taken old medication that was in the bathroom cabinet. [REDACTED] consumed an unknown number of Lorazepam pills with liquid Nyquil. [REDACTED] was incoherent and in and out of consciousness.

[REDACTED] advised me that she received a phone call today from House Principal #1, Mrs. Firstenberger. [REDACTED] went to her counselor, Mr. Daley, and advised him that students were spreading around a photo. [REDACTED] was in the photo, eyes closed and what appeared to be semen on her cheek. A friend of [REDACTED]'s told her about the photo. [REDACTED] knew which photo it was and became upset.

Mrs. Firstenberger advised [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] wanted to go home. [REDACTED] told Mrs. Firstenberger that was okay. [REDACTED] instructed Mrs. Firstenberger to let [REDACTED] go home and she would be en route from work. [REDACTED] went home from school.

[REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED] Ave. This is where [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] reside. [REDACTED] advised me that [REDACTED] was home alone for approximately thirty minutes before she arrived at the residence.

[REDACTED] was talking to [REDACTED] when she started slurring her words. [REDACTED] realized something was wrong and believed [REDACTED] took something. [REDACTED] then went into the bathroom and saw the empty prescription bottle and Nyquil.

[REDACTED] contacted [REDACTED] and advised him of what was going on. [REDACTED] got [REDACTED] into her vehicle and took her to Lakewood ED. Dr. Box was the attending physician.

[REDACTED] was incoherent and in and out of consciousness. I was unable to speak with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was being taken to the CT Scan department. I was advised that [REDACTED] will need to be transferred to a pediatric ICU. It had not been determined whether [REDACTED] would be transported to Fairview Hospital or Cleveland Clinic main campus.

[REDACTED] did not know the name of [REDACTED]'s friend that advised her of the picture being circulated in school. [REDACTED] had started to tell [REDACTED] about the picture before she became incoherent. [REDACTED] had known about the picture's existence.

[REDACTED] started to tell her mother that she goes over a friend's house

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sometimes and drinks alcohol, smokes marijuana, and passes out. [REDACTED] is not sure if the photo was taken during one of the times [REDACTED] passed out. [REDACTED] did not know who's residence [REDACTED] had been referring. The photo was not available when I spoke with the parents. It is unknown what device or devices the photo is currently saved on.

I advised [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] that I would do an information report. I advised [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] that the Juvenile Bureau would be following up with them. I had [REDACTED] sign a medical release waiver and attached it to the report. I called 696-kids and spoke with Terry. The intake number is [REDACTED].
